


Our World-Changing Impact

A report by London Economics on the University's impact (based on 2018-19 figures) found that:

- Total economic impact on the UK economy associated with the University's activities: £4.4 billion (42% from our research activity)
- £5.8million of impact for every £1million we spend
- We attract annual research income of £197 million+ per year.
- Our Widening Participation team works annually with more than 30,000 students across the West of Scotland.

Why Glasgow?


- Excellent health care data on everyone from birth to death.

- This location forefronts this research








