Treasurer's report for year ending February 28 2023

On February 28 2023 OSGUG had a total balance of £690 and no liabilities. Approximately £600 in total is expected in the year commencing March 1 2023 from membership subscriptions, so the Society remains solvent for 2023-2024. Around a dozen members are still paying their subscriptions into the old RBS account.

In 2022 OSGUG made a donation of £1000 to the University of Glasgow Student Hardship Funds. These funds are used to alleviate some of the pressure on students resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, bereavement, changed circumstances, natural disaster or armed conflict in their home countries.

During the year revenue and expenditure were as indicated below. Expenses were incurred as a result of a subscription to Zoom (used for virtual Last Tuesday Club meetings) and the registration cost of the OSGUG website.
